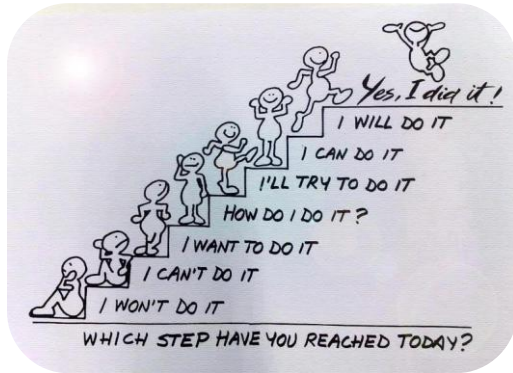


IT'S NOT ABOUT THE ACTIVITY, IT'S ABOUT THE LEARNING

KEY STAGE 1

Looking at nature activities, country walks, woodland play, minibeast hunts, pond life, small mammal habitats, simple team play, environmental art activities, outdoor sensory activities, photo safari

KEY STAGE 2

Team building, problem solving maths, woodland crafts, camp skills, knot tying, archery, bouldering, climbing, abseiling, trust activities, basis of survival, science of fire, expeditions, orienteering and map work, physical challenges, construction challenges, our environment (natural/ manmade).

KEY STAGE 3

Induction days for new year 7 intake, teamwork, team roles and leadership, physical and mental challenges, archery (junior progression award), bouldering, climbing (National Indoor Climbing Award Scheme) NICAS level 1, map and compass work, expedition preparation, basic youth first aid.

KEY STAGE 4

All of the previous can be adapted and delivered in a more challenging age appropriate way, progress through to higher junior archery progression award

ADULTS

Corporate team building days/ teacher training days that look at team roles and leadership skills, what is missing from the team, adapting to and need to change

ADDITIONAL/ SPECIAL/ BEHAVIOURAL NEEDS GROUPS

All of the activities that we deliver can be adapted and delivered in an age appropriate way to suit the needs of any group,
