Joining Instructions

The sessions will be run at Creed Outdoor Learning's new site at Millennium Wood, ISP School, Castlewood Farm, Conyer Road, Teynham, ME9 9LS



How to get to our new site in Teynham

Park on The Lower Road, Teynham, near Orchard view ME9 9DL marked yellow), go across the railway foot crossing at Sittingbourne end of Teynham station (opposite Orchard view) and walk a couple of hundred yards along the public footpath and go through the gate on the left into the woodland. **(marked RED, quickest, a 2-3 minute walk)** OR

Turnoff of the Lower Road onto Conyer Road (yellow line), turn into ISP School entrance/ farm area and head to the right, between the two barns down the long farm track until you come to a crossroads. Park on the concrete area on the right by the pile of rubble, then walk past the rubble, keeping it on your right, stop where the track bears right and turn left through the kissing gate back towards Teynham on the public footpath, through the orchard, through the next gate and then into the woodland on your right **(marked BLUE about a 4-5 min walk)**

YOUR CHILD/ CHILDREN WILL NEED

- Clothing that covers skin (long sleeves and trousers) that they do not mind getting dirty or wet
- A packed lunch including plenty of fluids on a hot day
- Face masks are optional (instructors will wear them if required closer than 1m to help)
- Suitable clothing for the weather on the day (sun hat/ cream if hot, waterproof jacket if rainy)
- Any mobile phones/ cameras or other equipment is the responsibility of the child
- Please inform Creed staff of any medication that your child/ children has with them,
- Your child will be asked to fill out a daily diary sheet to keep a record of what they have achieved/ liked etc
- All accidents/ incidents and behaviour issues will be reported to the person collecting the child on the day
- In the interests of all children attending disruptive or bullying behaviour will not be tolerated and warnings will be given (parents phoned as a last resort)
