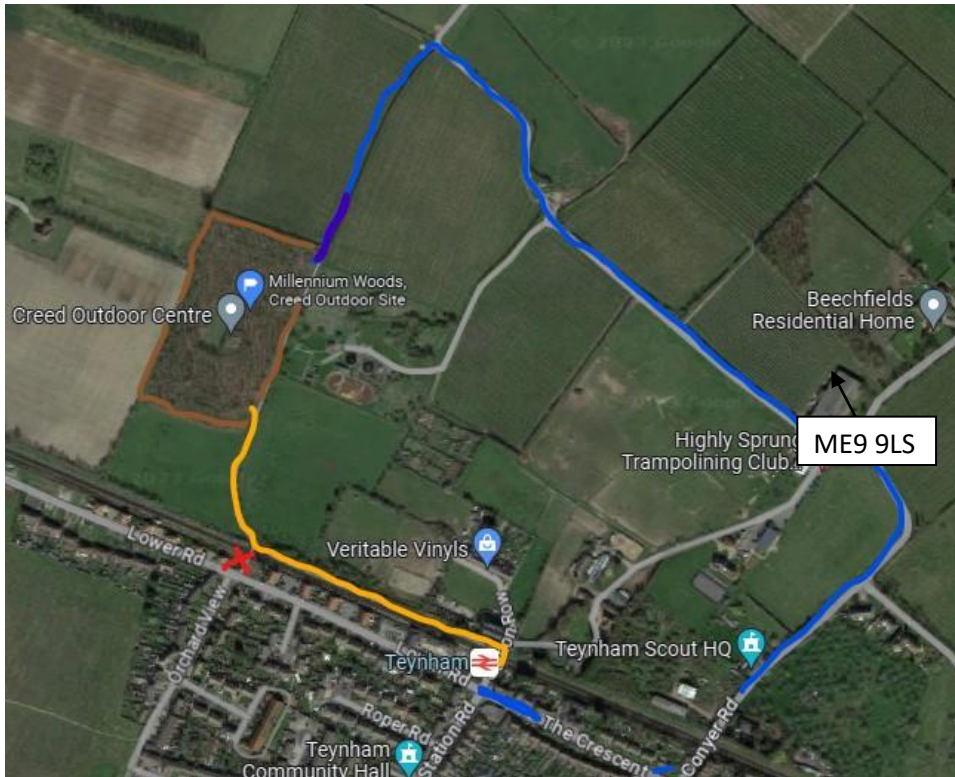

Creed Outdoor Learning Trust Joining Instructions

Sessions run at Creed Outdoor Learning's site at Millennium Woods, ISP School, Castlewood Farm, Conyer Road, Teynham, ME9 9EA



With the permanent closure of Teynham West railway foot crossing, this is how you now get to Creed Outdoor Learning's Site at Teynham.

BY FOOT = MARKED IN YELLOW - cross the railway at Teynham automatic barrier crossing (or via the adjacent footbridge) go onto the down platform (platform 2) and walk along the platform to the opposite end (staying away from the platform edge, behind the yellow line) go through the kissing gate and proceed along the footpath to the gate leading into the woodland (Millennium Woods) on the left

BY CAR - MARKED IN BLUE - from Teynham station, head east along THE CRESCENT, then turn left onto CONYER ROAD, turn into Castlewood Farm and head down the farm track between the two barns, continue down the track until you get to a fence directly in front of you, then turn left into the orchard, proceed to the other end of the orchard and park in the dark blue area shown on map leaving space for farm vehicles to get around the trees

CREED OUTDOOR LEARNING'S MILLENNIUM WOODS SITE - Is outlined in brown on the map

Network Rail are looking to put a new pathway along the back of the down platform but as of yet have no fixed start/ completion date

WE RECOMMEND YOUR CHILD/ CHILDREN WILL NEED - Clothing that covers skin (long sleeves and trousers) that they do not mind getting dirty or wet; A packed lunch including plenty of fluids on a hot day, Suitable clothing for the weather on the day (sun hat/ cream if hot, waterproof jacket if rainy), Any mobile phones/ cameras or other equipment is the responsibility of the child' Please inform Creed staff of any medication that your child/ children has with them, All accidents/ incidents and behaviour issues will be reported to the person collecting the child on the day, In the interests of all children attending disruptive or bullying behaviour will not be tolerated and warnings will be given (parents phoned as a last resort)
